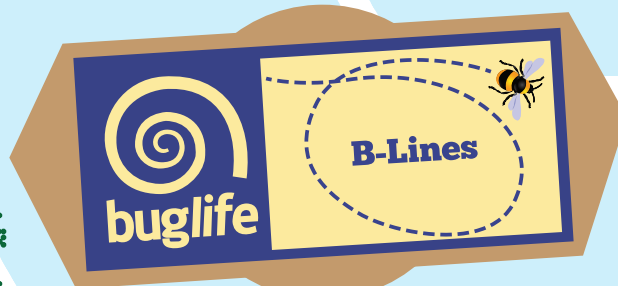
Buglife is developing a network of wildflowers – The B-Lines - stretching across the UK, from the coast up into our hills and mountains, and from the countryside into our towns and cities.
