How to make a Seed Bomb



How to Plant your Seed Bombs

You can throw your bombs at spots of bare earth in your garden to scatter the seed.
Alternatively, break up the ball over a bare bit of ground or in a pot and watch your wildflowers grow. Some good flowers to include are:

- Red Clover (Trifolium pratense),
- Bird's Foot Trefoil (Lotus corniculatus)
- Bulbous Buttercup (Ranunculus bulbosus).

What you will need

- Peat-free compost
- Wildflower seed
- Powdered clay (or clay soil)
- Water
- Measuring cup
- Mixing bowl (or something to mix in)

Instructions

- 1. In a mixing bowl, mix together 1 cup of seeds with 5 cups of compost and 2-3 cups of clay powder.
- 2. Mix in water gradually until the mixture becomes sticky.
- 3. Roll mixture into small balls, about the size of a tennis ball.
- 4. Leave the balls to dry in the sun for 1-2 hours.
- 5. Plant your seed bombs!
